- To fill your vacancies with the right young person we need to understand your business and the job/s you want to fill.
 Our Regional Engagement Specialists will invest time in getting to know your business and the requirements and qualifications for your vacancies
- You can lodge your vacancies online through our website 24/7.

We can help you select the right person for your business needs:

- Based on your requirements we can help you recruit young people by:
 - Pre-screening each applicant and matching their skillset, motivation, aptitude and attitude to your vacancy
 - Arranging work trials to see if the young person is suitable for your vacancy
 - Providing tailored vocational and non-vocational preemployment training, including in some licenses through our RTO partners
 - Assisting with apprenticeship and traineeship selections
 - Informing you of wage incentives and subsidies from Federal, State and local initiatives and programs

And if we do not have the right person for your job we will work with other providers to get you the right person

Employing young people with us will reduce your business costs.

We assist you and your employee on-the-job with Post Placement Support:

Our Youth Mentor will support your young employee on-the-job
through agreed regular contacts over a 6 month period. This may
occur through online, phone or on-site visits where we provide
mentoring or additional training, if required, to support job
retention. If you are concerned regarding your employee,
contact us and we will immediately visit and put in place a plan
to get things back on track.
