As specialists in youth employment, we will listen to young people and provide a personalised and flexible service that is based around their needs.

Our youth-friendly Transition to Work teams work alongside young people aged 15 to 24 and provide practical support to secure a job, complemented by education or training. We respond to young people's needs by building their employability skills and developing their strengths to achieve their aspirations.

It's all about tailoring the young person's journey around them from choosing their Job Placement Coach, through to how they'd like to connect with us.

Opportunities to upskill through training; develop your employability and life skills through workshops; and participate in 'on the job' tasters through work experience.

Partnering with schools, education providers and local RTOs, we can identify and source opportunities to provide individual education pathways relevant to the young person's goals. We strive to ensure services respond to the cultural and social factors unique to each young person. Working collaboratively with Elders and Cultural Services within the community, not only provides a connection point for our young people but also strengthens our understanding of different cultures and how we can best tailor our ways of working and communicating to meet their individual needs.

Who is eligible & how do I refer?

We make it easy for community organisations to interact with us and commit to providing regular updates across support networks throughout the young person's journey with us in Transition to Work. It's important you know that young people don't need to be on Centrelink payments to be eligible.

Young people may be eligible for Transition to Work if they are:

- 15-24 years old
- An Australian Citizen, or permanent visa holder, or a nominated visa holder (including a New Zealand Special Category visa holder, temporary protection visa holder, and a safe haven visa holder)

Eligibility is dependent upon the young person's circumstances, and takes into account their participation in education and/or employment.
