



National Careers Institute Advisory Board Communiqué

The National Careers Institute (NCI) Advisory Board held a meeting on Thursday 17 November 2022.

The Advisory Board was informed that the Jobs and Skills Australia Act came into effect on Wednesday 16 November 2022, repealing the National Skills Commissioner, Mr Adam Boyton. The NCI are thankful for Mr Boyton's contributions and commitment to the Advisory Board as an ex-officio member.

The Advisory Board was asked to provide advice on the NCI's future strategic direction, noting much has changed since the NCI was first established. Planning is currently underway to reconsider and simplify the NCI's strategic objectives and reporting structure.

Board members provided advice on strategies to best manage increased and ongoing demand for the School Leavers Information Service (SLIS), noting the measure is only funded until June 2023.

The Advisory Board was presented with a draft Forward Work Plan for 2023 for consideration ahead of the next meeting.

The NCI Advisory Board is next scheduled to meet in February 2023.
