DEWR collates all reporting information across all relevant entities and eligible projects to determine overall program performance.

This template is to be used for all major ICT and construction projects over \$10 million, and flagship construction projects over \$100 million, which are subject to the Australian Skills Guarantee.

Upon execution of the work order or contract, the GEAP (as submitted in the response to the approach to market) is considered to be approved by the relevant entity.
