The Australian Government is investing \$189.7 million in a range of jobs and skills measures in the **More Choices for a Longer Life** package.



## MEET BRIAN

Brian is 47 and is looking to change jobs and move into the healthcare industry after hearing that the automotive company he has worked at for the last 10 years will be closing in six months time.

## CONNECTING RETRENCHED WORKERS TO SUPPORT AND SERVICES

From 1 July 2018 the Retrenchment Rapid Response Framework will be available to connect Brian to support and services.

## BETTER ACCESS TO INFORMATION ABOUT CAREER PATHWAYS

From 1 July 2019, Brian will have access to the **Skills Transferability Tool** on the Job Outlook website. Through the tool, Brian will be able to identify related jobs and careers that match his current skills, knowledge and attributes and identify what skill gaps he may have.

## EARLY ACCESS TO AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

From 1 July 2019 **Brian's partner** will be eligible to receive **early access to employment services** due to Brian's retrenchment.

## HELP TO FIND A JOB IN A GROWTH INDUSTRY

Brian will be eligible to register for the **Automotive Industry Structural Adjustment program**.

Through the Automotive Industry Structural Adjustment program, he will receive **tailored assistance** to find a new job.

The Automotive Industry Structural Adjustment program has been extended for a year until 30 June 2019.

## LOCAL ASSISTANCE

Brian will also be able to attend local **jobs fairs**, where he can talk directly to a range of employers about the skills they are looking for and find out about available job opportunities.
