WHS RESPONSIBILITIES

WHS is everyone's responsibility

Providers and Activity Host Organisations have a legal requirement to be aware of their Work, Health and Safety (WHS) obligations including what to do if they identify a potential hazard, and ensuring Participants are aware of the role they have in maintaining safe workspaces, and reporting incidents including injures and near misses.

WHS and Incidents

 Report all incidents and hazards as soon as possible to the supervisor/ host organisation and/or provider

Insurance

- Keep receipts
- Complete claim form
- Ask your provider for help

Host Organisation

WHS and Incidents

- Provide a safe environment
- Offer medical assistance
- Review Risk Assessment
- Support participant
- Notify participant's provider of incident

Insurance

 Maintain relevant organisation insurance

Participant Provider

WHS and Incidents

- Complete incident report
- Offer support to participant
- Review risk assessment

Insurance

- Maintain relevant organisation insurance
- Help participant complete claim form
- Help participant submit claim
- Follow up with insurer
- Offer support to participant
