

Transition to Work: Service Delivery Plan for Participants

Are you aged 15 to 24 and want skills and support to get a job or further education? If so, **Real Futures** is committed to help you reach your potential by helping you into a job or education. We have designed a Transition to Work (TtW) service that enables you to control your job or education pathway.

How we help you

- Our Youth Mentors will:
 - work with you to assess what assistance you need to find a job or return to education/training
 - check your wellbeing and arrange for support services where these are needed
 - develop a Job Plan with short and long term goals as well as career building pathways which will be reviewed quarterly
 - help you with career advice, preparation of resumes, job applications and interview preparation
 - arrange for you to develop skills through training which builds on your strengths, abilities and interests.
- We are flexible - we can meet with you face to face at our Youth Hub or via our mobile hubs, or via Zoom /Facetime/text/chat - you can contact us 24/7
- We provide you with free access to WiFi, private spaces and computers
- We respect your privacy and provide culturally relevant support. Indigenous participants will have access to our Indigenous Mentors
- We know the local labour market and have close relationships with local employers so we can train you for local jobs and provide work trials including apprenticeships and traineeships
- We generate job opportunities using our extensive employer, industry and training networks
- We work proactively with your local community and other support services to support you
- When you are in a job or education we provide Post Placement Support which includes regular contacts, to ensure you have settled into your job or study
- We will provide you with information about job opportunities in other locations across Australia and
