I understand that the government will be introducing new IR legislation later this year, following the workplace reforms consultations processes that have recently closed.

Some of the measures the government will be pursuing are Same Job, Same Pay; criminalizing wage theft; extending FWC powers to include 'employee-like' forms of work; protections against discrimination; national framework for labour hire; improving conditions for casual workers, etc.

Workplace reforms is an area of interest for Zoe Daniel MP, and she hopes to continue engage with the government on these issues constructively, in consultation with her electorate and stakeholders.

I wanted to ask about

- 1. If the government intends to introduce a number of discrete pieces of legislation for each
 - a. What are the bills we can expect?
 - b. When might each of the bills be introduced?
- 2. If the government intends to introduce a single workplace reforms bill encompassing all the measures
 - a. When might be bill be introduced?
 - b. What resources can we expect the Minister's office to provide independent Members to support their understanding and decision-making process (to support/oppose the reforms) of this complex legislation?

If we are able to get this information about what we might expect in the spring (and beyond) in terms of workplace reforms legislation, it would be really useful for our preparation and consultation with groups in the coming weeks.
