




Dear Madam/Sir

My organisation supports the submission made by ASENA, including their three recommendations:

RECOMMENDATION 1: When disadvantaged job seekers are engaged by a WISE, the WISE receives the full funding available to licenced Providers and Employers if and when they deliver the support and employment outcomes sought by the NESM. RECOMMENDATION 2: This happens via 'wage subsidy-plus' agreements between WISEs and Providers, that pass on not only wage subsidies, but any relevant Provider payments and Employment Fund payments when associated criteria are met. RECOMMENDATION 3: Compliance relating to the Points Based Activity System not be required for WISE employees (or automatically logged as 100 points).
