Every fortnight a group session is run with up to 12 prisoners. Prisoners and the TWES provider meet face to face here at this session and the prisoners sign up for the program. The TWES provider then meets with the prisoners in visits with a one on one up to 3 times before release. Once released I have not heard of the TWES provider meeting with their job provider (Workforce Australia or CDP) and assisting them with any barriers into employment.

The TWES provider however does do a transition plan with the prisoner which includes the medical and transcript from the EC and this is sent to the EC to put on the prisoners file. I would like to see more outcomes with this program with overcoming barriers in employment, training or entering the workforce. I do not have this feedback and believe it is not done. The job provider here engages with the prisoners in a Job club before release and after release.
