Eligible types of renewable energy include solar, bioenergy, wind power, hydro power, battery storage geothermal energy and smart technology.

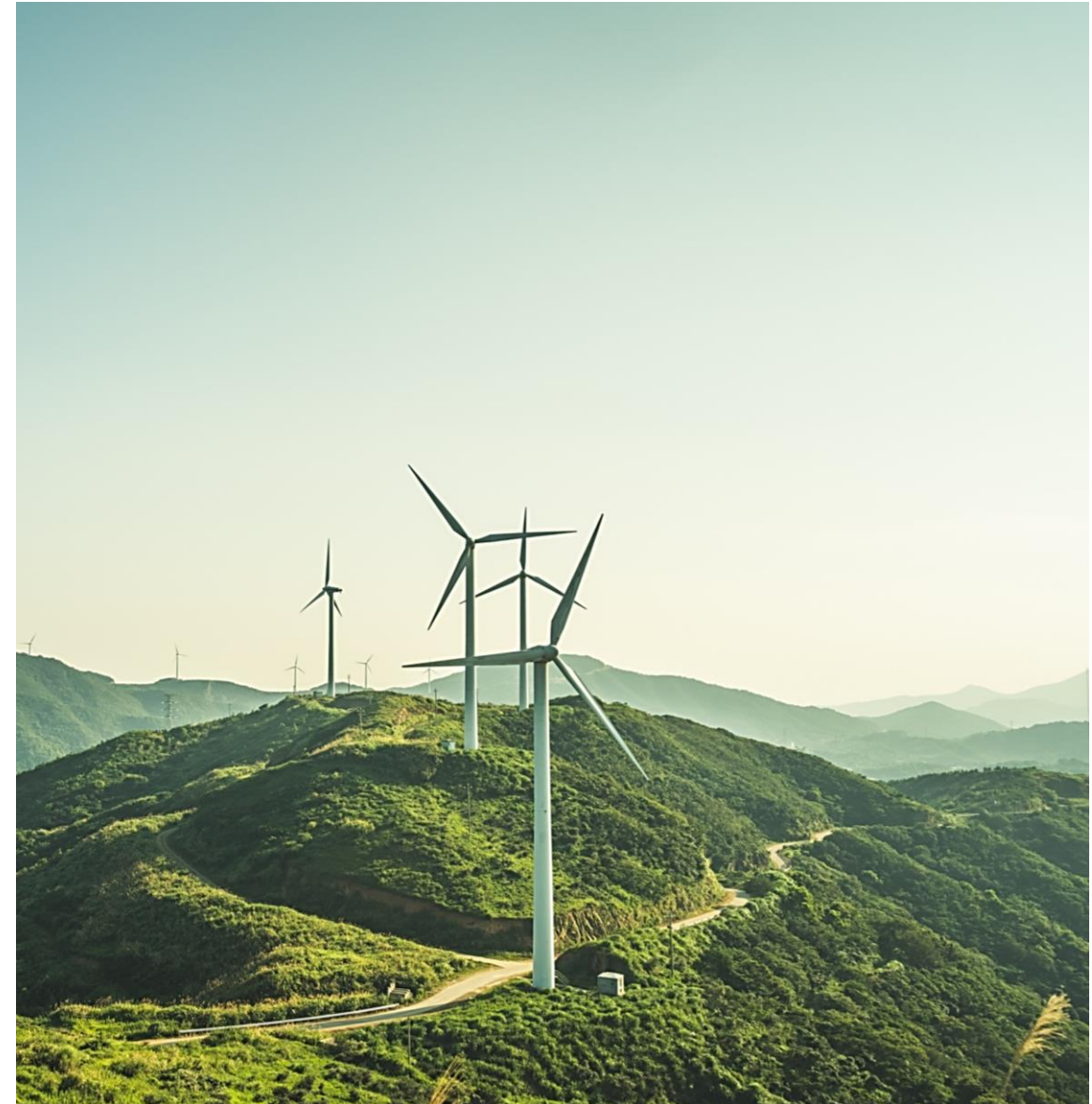

The **National Apprenticeship Employment Network (NAEN)** is Australia's largest employer network of apprentices and trainees.

Across metropolitan, rural, regional and remote Australia, the network employs some 25,000 apprentices and trainees in a diverse range of industries.

The employer network is unique, as it represents the practice of Group Training under which Group Training Organisations (GTOs) directly employ apprentices and trainees and place them with host businesses.

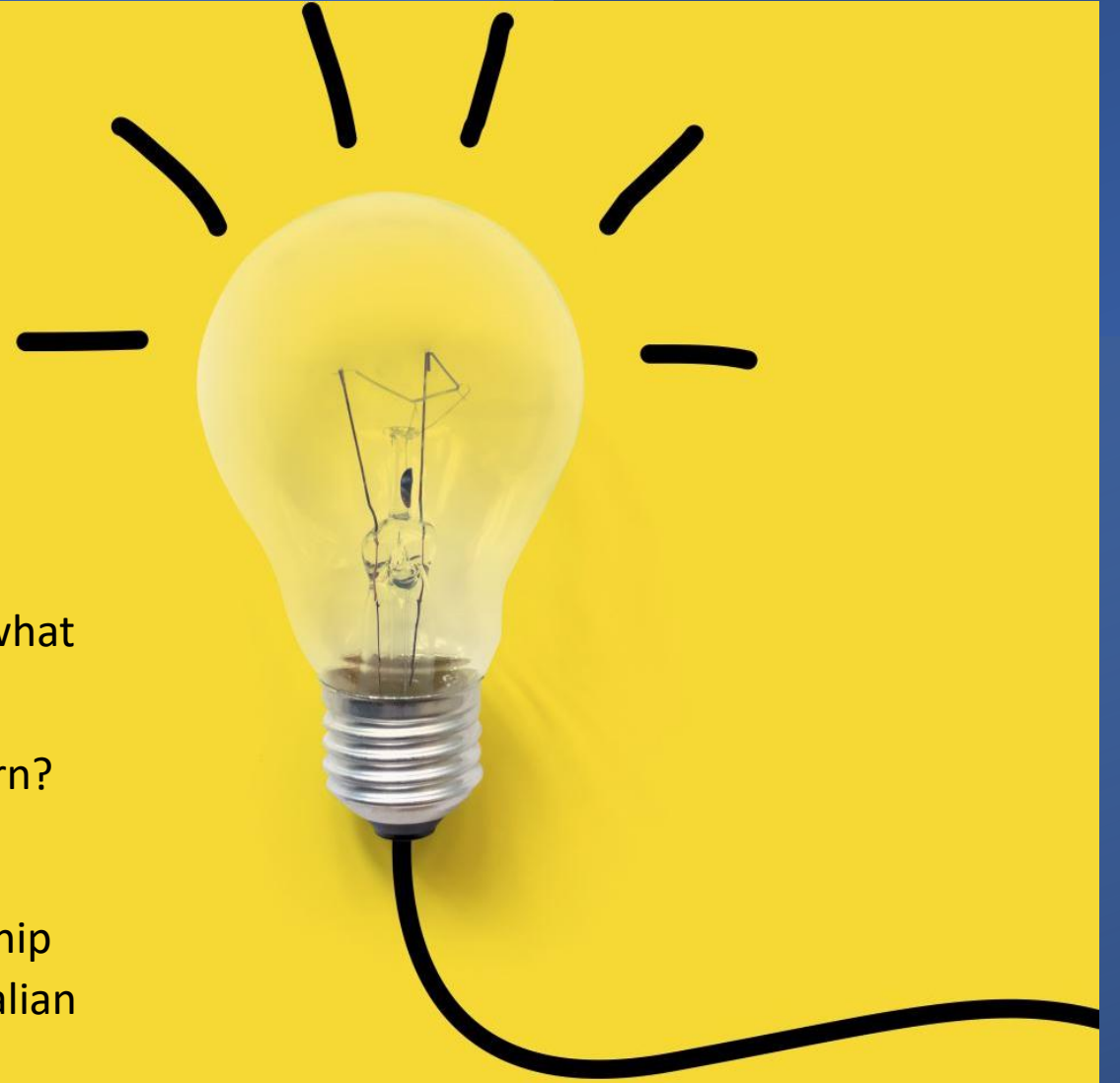

- ✓ Assist to develop career ideas and check your eligibility
- ✓ Help you find an employer and registered training organisation to complete your training
- ✓ Offers personalised advice and support services during your apprenticeship
- ✓ Provide targeted services for individuals who need extra support to complete their apprenticeship
- ✓ Advise and assess if you're eligible for financial and non-financial support from the Australian Government
- ✓ Advise if additional support for off-the-job training is available if you have a disability (including if you are diagnosed with ADD or ADHD or are experiencing difficulty)

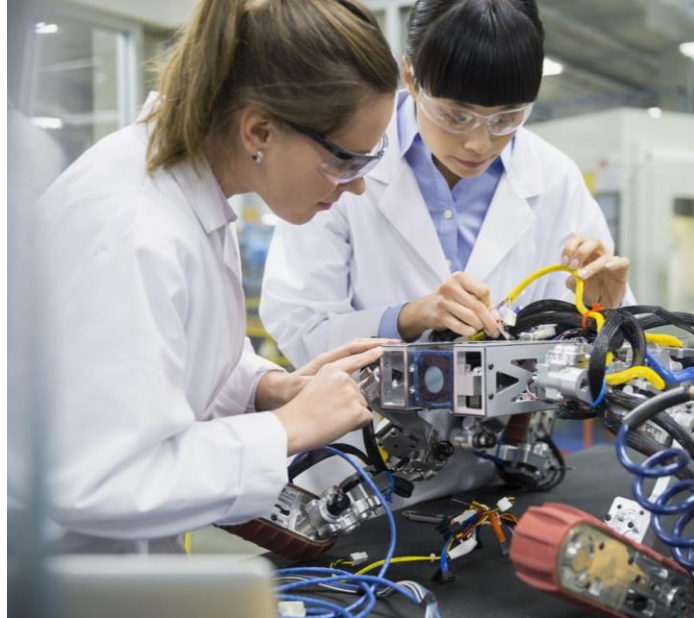
Job alerts
