## 1 Why is the ban in place?

Some engineered stone workers have been diagnosed with a life threatening and avoidable disease called silicosis.

Safe Work Australia found the disease was linked to the silica dust released when cutting, drilling or polishing engineered stone.


Australia banned the material to keep engineered stone workers safe.




#### 2 What's included in the ban?
