PURSUANT TO THE AMENDED SENATE ORDER ON DEPARTMENTAL AND AGENCY CONTRACTS THE FOLLOWING TABLE SETS OUT NON-PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS ENTERED INTO BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND TRAINING WHICH PROVIDES FOR A CONSIDERATION TO THE VALUE OF \$100,000 OR MORE AND WHICH:
