

# FEE-FREE TAFE ENROLMENT DATA<sup>1</sup>

Through the Fee-Free TAFE Skills Agreement, the Commonwealth Government has partnered with states and territories to deliver over \$1.5 billion funding for 500,000 Fee-Free TAFE and vocational education and training (VET) places across Australia over 2023 to 2026. Since January 2023 to 30 September 2024, Fee-Free TAFE has:
